What to include in your comment:

Your name & address and the date

Site address Broom Hill/Brislington Meadows Broomhill Road Bristol
BS4 4UD

A comment is required to be 'material' (relevant) to be considered by the planning department. An example of what **is material would be:**

1. Effect on trees and wildlife
2. Highway safety
3. Impact on community and services
4. Drainage and flood risk
5. Traffic and parking issues

What is not material:

1. Loss of views
2. Loss of property value
3. Construction noise/disturbance during development.
