Green Trail update

- The CIL funded Brislington Green Trail is progressing well after a few earlier hiccups. The partners have all started their projects and some are completed.
- Completed: signage at Arnos Vale Cemetery (AVCT) complete with BGT logo. A route from park to A4 and A37 is now on the avct leaflet.
- Window Wanderland was very successful and has now happened.
- ▶ The improvements to the Well on behalf of the Friends of Brislington Brook have been completed.
- In progress: Eastwood Community Garden is now named Eastwynd Community Garden. It is progressing well, with planters, a water butt and composters. A green house is just being installed.
- Sandy Park Road Improvement Group (SPRING) have started installing planters to green the road. The originally proposed green bus shelter roofs were sadly vetoed so this is an excellent alternative
- Friends of Eastwood Farm signage improvements?
- BS4 youth were making great progress in their community garden but have suffered serious vandalism. Some elements of the project are being reconsidered because of it.
